

What are your Student Health & Dental Benefits?

Prescription Drug, Extended Health, Dental and Travel coverage that fills the gaps in your provincial health care. Built specifically for you by the University of Windsor Students' Alliance.

Eligibility & Pricing

Undergraduate students enrolled in 4 or more courses and paying full time fees for the academic year are automatically covered under the UWSA Health & Dental benefits. These students would see charges for Health Insurance (\$251) and Dental Insurance (\$174) on their tuition breakdown. Full Co-Op, Waiver & Exchange students must manually opt-in. Please note there are eligibility exceptions.

Keep in Mind:

You can combine both plans to get up to 100% coverage. Your alternative insurance may not be as comprehensive, or it may stop covering you if you are a part-time student over 21, or full-time student over 25.

When can I Opt-In/Out?

Fall Opt-In: August 18 - September 30, 2025

Fall Opt-Out: September 1 - September 30, 2025

Winter Opt-In/Opt-Out: January 2 - January 31, 2026


