

KEY THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT YOUR PLAN

Your insurance does not cover everything!

Review your benefits before using the plan.

PRE-EXISTING HEALTH CONDITIONS

Illnesses or injuries you have when arriving to Canada may not be eligible for coverage. Pre-existing conditions must be stable for 90 days prior to coverage starting.

ASU SUPPORTS

ASU Supports is the on-campus health plan office available to assist you with your health plan questions.

MAKE A CLAIM

If you have paid up front for your health care, you can file a claim online at asusupports.ca under the 'Make a Claim' section.

WHO IS ON THE PLAN?

All international students studying at Acadia University are automatically on the plan and the fee is added to your student account. **Some exceptions may apply.*

FAMILY COVERAGE

You can opt-in your eligible family members for coverage during the opt-in period online. Additional fees apply.

SEE A DOCTOR

Doctors are available on campus to treat your health concerns and prescribe medication. These campus doctors will accept your insurance so you do not have to pay out of pocket.

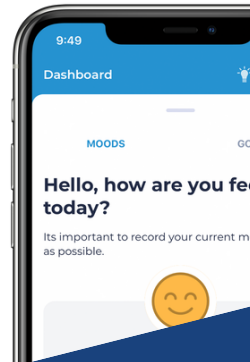
I.M. Well

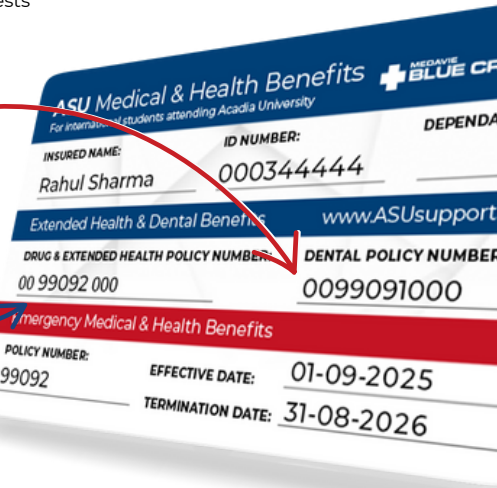
